5. FIRST PUBLIC FORUM

The Chairman closed the meeting for a discussion to take place by residents on the proposed development on Lopham/Garboldisham Road.

The Chairman reassured residents that the Parish Council will continue to strongly oppose this application.

6. PLANNING

- a. Gladman Developments (3PL/2018/1557O) *The Council will continue to oppose this application reiterating its original comments and counteracting any of the amendments in its comments to be submitted to Breckland.*
- b. Plot at Pegasus Lodge (3PL/2019/0962) *Council to object to this application by 8 against, 2 support and 1 Council abstained from voting. Needless infill, plot on a dangerous corner with no footpath.*
- c. Development plot at Flint Corner, Eccles Road (3PL/2019/0760) *Variation on Condition 2 Objection due to the property not being built in accordance with the original plans.*
- d. Land North of Lime Kiln House (3PL/2019/0979) *Council objects strongly to the increase from 4 to 6 properties on this site, an over development of site with large properties when there is clearly not a need locally for this size of property.*
- e. 6 The Crescent (3PL/2019/0963) *Concerns raised over listed building status and building not being in keeping. Also will this be used as a business premises.*
